 - o Upon completion of the 2-year training program, the candidates need to observe a 2-years employment undertaking. Working location subject to prevailing business needs and mutual agreement, priority will be parking back in OOCL EU offices where appropriate.

- Performance measurement: specific Key Performance Indicators with semi-annual revision by respective functional supervisors to ensure learning progress and performance

4. Preparedness of international mobility
